**SUBMISSION PROCEDURE**

Submission procedure of international book which is planned to publish with partnership of Peter Lang International Publishing House, one of the biggest and high reputed publishing houses based in Germany, is given below.

- 1) Chapter proposals should be between 1,000 to 2,000 words including type of research, approach, context, connection to the book, and other pertinent information with word (docx) format. Authors should send proposals to editor@inglobe.org.
- 2) Chapter proposals should include names, work and titles, mailing addresses, e-mail addresses and phone numbers of authors in same word file.
- 3) Biographies of authors should be added, maximum 150 words, to end of proposal word document in same file.
- 4) Authors should follow acceptance, proofreading and decline announcements and answer in time.
- 5) Authors should use Cambria font with 12 pt.
